
Marketing and **Promoting Training**

2. Coaching and Mentoring

This phase of the programme does not only provide you with guidance and direction, but supports real-life training to build up your practical experience. The coaching and mentorship portion has two parts; Skill Coaching and Business Coaching.



Skill Coaching:

You will be assigned a Skill Coach who will work closely with you to help you acquire the 53 competencies quickly and narrow down some of the gaps in competencies that you might need to improve on. Get into the training profession in the shortest time possible. The Skill Coaches are experienced professional trainers chosen specially for their high level of training skills and expertise.

Business Coaching:

Once you have completed the Business Programme (Part 2) you will have the templates and knowledge to make certain business decisions, thus enabling you to prepare your marketing plan for your Training Business. Upon submission of your marketing plan, the Business Coach will be assigned to discuss with you, examine and validate your Marketing plan. The Business Coach will then work with you to get your Plan implemented through a one-year coaching engagement.

3. Apprenticeship and Assessment

There are two types of live training assignments you will be required to carry out.









Apprenticeship:

There will be opportunities to be an apprentice at actual training sessions secured by Quest. You will be periodically informed of Quest training projects which you can participate in. Your participation as an apprentice, where you will be involved in a live training event is where you will learn the process and dynamics of a real-world training environment. This on-the-job learning experience is invaluable.

Assessment:

Once you have completed Part 1A, 1B and Part 2, and you have done your skill coaching, you can request for an assessment. You are required to organise and carry out a live training session (not less than 2 hours) with a live audience (not less than 20 persons) where you will be evaluated by a CPT Assessor. The assessment can be done live or can be videotaped and submitted to the CPT Assessor. The result of the assessment will determine whether or not you are awarded the Certification from IPMA, U.K.


